## **Neptune's Production Ramp-up on Target**

*Reaches annualized production capacity of 50 metric tons*

**Laval, Québec, CANADA – August 14, 2014** – Neptune Technologies & Bioresources Inc. (“Neptune” or the “Corporation”) (NASDAQ.NEPT - TSX.NTB), announces that its Sherbrooke plant is now operating at an annualized production capacity of 50 metric tons.

“Production levels are on target and we continue to focus on reaching full operating capacity of 150 metric tons of krill oil annually at the end of a three-month ramp-up period” highlighted Mr. André Godin, Interim President and Chief Executive Officer of Neptune. “Customer demand for our premium krill oil, NKO<sup>®</sup>, remains firm. Before commencing customer shipments, additional tests on the krill oil will be performed to ensure quality standards are being met.”

As announced on July 15, 2014 Neptune has entered a three-month production ramp-up at its Sherbrooke plant. During this time, annualized production capacity is expected to grow in equal monthly increments of 50 metric tons, increasing from 50 metric tons at the end of the first month, to 150 metric tons at the end of the third month.

### **About Neptune Technologies & Bioresources Inc.**

Neptune is a biotechnology company engaged primarily in the development and commercialization of marine-derived omega-3 polyunsaturated fatty acids (“**PUFAs**”). Neptune has a patented process of extracting oils from Antarctic krill, and principally sells omega-3 PUFAs as **bulk** oil to Neptune’s distributors who commercialize them under their private label primarily in the U.S., European and Australian nutraceutical markets. Neptune’s products generally come in bulk oil or capsule form and serve as a dietary supplement to consumers. Neptune’s head office is located at 545 Promenade du Centropolis, Suite 100, Laval, Quebec.

Neptune holds approximately 49% of the participating and voting rights of Acasti Pharma Inc. (“**Acasti**”) and 95% of the voting rights of NeuroBioPharm Inc. (“**NeuroBio**”). Through these subsidiaries, Neptune is also pursuing opportunities in the medical food and prescription drug markets. Acasti and NeuroBioPharm respectively focus on the research and development of safe and therapeutically effective compounds for highly prevalent atherosclerotic conditions, such as cardiometabolic disorders and cardiovascular diseases, and for neurodegenerative and inflammation related conditions. Acasti’s lead prescription drug candidate is CaPre<sup>®</sup>, a purified high omega-3 phospholipid concentrate derived from Neptune krill oil being developed to address the prevention and treatment of cardiometabolic disorders, including hypertriglyceridemia, which is characterized by abnormally high levels of triglycerides.
